Moment For Missions

(MTW Regional Director for the Caribbean)

Dear Partners in Ministry.

January 23-28 we attended MTW's Refresh Conference near Orlando which was a good time of spiritual renewal, fellowship with missionary colleagues, and evaluating ministry over the past five years. A good start to a new year.

We are looking forward to 2023 of ministry throughout the Caribbean and we wanted to give you a preview of the ministry opportunities coming up this year:

- February 28-March 31 we will be in Belize. Anita will assist at the clinic, Garry will help to fill the pulpit for churches without a pastor and also cover a Sunday for John Stodghill, allowing him to meet with local church leaders to discuss several areas of ministry.
- April 22-28, Anita will join an MTW medical team going to the Dominican Republic and Garry will be teaching a course on *The Mission of the Church* for Haitian church leaders that same week also in the Dominican Republic. Please be praying for Garry as he is currently writing and developing the course.
- In May we plan to go to Nassau, Bahamas to minister with the Covenant Life Church plant and MTW missionaries Julian and Christiana Russel.
- We will have a second trip to Belize in July-August for 4-6 weeks to assist with summer teams and minister with the missionaries and local churches.
- Garry will be developing and writing another course on Church Planting Methodology to teach to Haitian church leaders in the Dominican Republic late August.
- Mission to the World is hosting an Area Retreat for missionaries serving in the Americas; South America, Central America, Mexico, Caribbean, and Indigenous Ministries in North America (USA and Canada) in the Dominican Republic, October 3-9. This is an every 4 year event that was postponed a year due to COVID. We are hoping to lead a marriage seminar the weekend before the retreat for Haitian couples living in eastern Dominican Republic.
- Garry is planning a trip to Trinidad and Grenada, once details are finalized for course content, for the new Youth Ministry Training program which we plan to launch this fall. Please be praying for the details to come together quickly.
- November 13-17 we will participate in a MTW Missiological/Leadership Conference with location to be announced.

There are one or two other possible trips pending on how circumstances develop. Please be praying for these ministry trips:

- Ask God for wisdom in preparing and presenting course material.
- Pray for God's protection and good health during travel.
- Pray for Anita as she works with medical volunteers going to Belize and serves on the Dominican Republic medical team.
- Please pray for financial resources to cover travel expenses. Our support account is healthy but with the
 rising cost of travel we project that we will need additional funds to cover travel costs this year. If you

- We appreciate your prayers for our daily ministry of giving oversight and guidance for MTW's ministries throughout the Caribbean.
