**Sermon Outline:** *Jonah 3* “Prophet on the Rise”

**When God sets his saving grace on a nation, there is no stopping him.**

**1. God Always Gets His Man (vv. 1-5)**

- a. God’s Grace to Jonah (vv. 1-2)
- b. Jonah’s Duty (v. 3)
- c. God’s Power despite Jonah (v. 4)
- d. **Application:** God uses even the shortest proclamation of his Word for wide transformation.

**2. God Always Gets His Nation (vv. 5-10)**

- a. Immediate Repentance (v. 5)
- b. Nationwide Repentance (vv. 5-6)
- c. Top-to-Bottom Repentance (vv. 3-8)
- d. Biblical Repentance (vv. 8-9)
- e. **Application:** Divine relenting is based on genuine repentance (v. 10).
