Dear Partners in Ministry, August 1, 2024

Greetings from Belize! In just two days, Garry and I will depart Belize after a very fruitful summer of leading 3 teams, assisting at the clinic and finishing administrative responsibilities. We feel privileged to be a part of the Belize culture and ministering alongside of church members and their leaders.

The last team was from Kosciusko, Mississippi. This church has quite a history of supporting the Presbyterian churches in the Yucatan area of Mexico, who came to plant churches in Belize in the late 1950's! Even though it was a small team of 5, they came with enthusiasm and enough support to totally renovate the church roof (from bat infestation) of the Mount Sinai Presbyterian church of Xaibe village. They helped to paint the church and new ceiling fans and lights were installed. One Belizean church member gave testimony that she had had a dream about their church turning into a beautiful place, so transformation took place and now it is known as 'the pretty pink church'. The Belizean church members organized an exciting VBS program with almost 50 local children plus several adults and on the last day children placed their painted handprints on the back of the church sign.

We head back to Florida and will be traveling more in August, visiting a supporting church and seeing

our youngest daughter, Rebecca and her family.
