

Dear Partners in Ministry,

We are packing bags as we prepare to return home after two weeks in Belize. We were able to visit, meet, and worship with many people on this trip. Anita shared the gospel and prayed with patients and Garry preached at five different churches, three on one Sunday and two on the other. We visited with friends in their homes, prayed with people struggling with health issues, and shared meals with them. Garry was able to finish most of the administrative items on his list and Anita assisted the clinic staff with several procedures and patient care needs.

We would like to thank those who have given towards the funds needed to hold the next youth ministry training class which begins on April 22. Praise God that with the gifts received and those promised I believe we will raise the full amount. Thank you!

Also, this month a dentist and hygienist will be serving at the clinic 5-12 and a medical team of 15 people will be serving in the Dominican Republic April 26 to May 3. Please pray for these ministries, that their contacts will make an impact on patients' spiritual lives and decisions for Christ will be made.
