Ministry Opportunities - Cross Creek needs YOU!

Hospitality Team – Set-up / clean-up the weekly coffee service in the narthex. This provides a sense of welcome to our guests and opportunity for members to connect with one another. Useful spiritual gifts: hospitality, service, leadership. Ideal team of four that would serve together for a year (renewable).

Fellowship Events Team – Plan the regular fellowship events in the life of the congregation. This provides an opportunity for people to connect with each other and build multi-generational friendships. Includes after-church meals and any social events for the entire congregation. Useful spiritual gifts: hospitality, administration, encouragement, faith, intercession, leadership. Ideal team of six that would serve together for a year (renewable). Would recruit others with gifts to help provide needed support for individual events.

Library Team – Catalogue and manage the church Library, provide updates on good reads, new selections, etc. Useful spiritual gifts: administration, discernment, helps. Ideal team of two to serve together for a year (renewable)

Prayer Ministry Team – Coordinate the corporate prayer ministry of Cross Creek so that individuals, families and the ministries of Cross Creek are faithfully prayed for. Supports the shepherding efforts of the Elders. Useful spiritual gifts: intercession, discernment, shepherding, wisdom. Ideal team of four that would serve together for a year (renewable).

Sacrament Prep Team – Prepare the elements for serving weekly communion as well as any baptisms. Useful spiritual gifts: service, encouragement. Ideal team of four alternate week by week, that can serve together for a year (renewable).

Flourish Officer Retreat: Saturday, May 31st. Please be in prayer for our Elders and Deacons as they pray, discuss, and develop a strategic plan to address the key issues identified by the Congregational Health Survey. Please pray especially for discernment, ability to hear and weigh differing options, unity in decision making, and wisdom in implementation.

Family Forum: Sunday, June 8th following the morning worship service. Families are invited to bring a picnic lunch (room in the kitchen frig if needed). Cross Creek will provide extra drinks. At this townhall, we will be seeking input on the functionality and upgrading of space designated for ministry to children and youth. Cross Creek is growing and we want to be adequately prepared and ready for significant spiritual ministry to young families and their children. Your participation is greatly appreciated.
