Dear Partners in Ministry,

As August comes to an end, Anita and I are preparing for upcoming trips in September. Anita leaves on Saturday, the 6th for Belize. She travels with Elaine Welch, RN to serve at the Presbyterian Medical Clinic. They will assist the nursing staff in treating patients, present some medical in-service topics for the staff, and encourage the local church. Anita returns on September 20th. Pray for good health (the flu has struck early in Belize this year), safety, and for effective ministry.

Garry travels to Grenada on Wednesday 10th - Monday 15th with a prospective missionary couple to serve alongside The Grenada Institute for Theological Education. Ask God to give wisdom and direction to the discussions as we consider the possibility of first-time missionaries serving in Grenada. Garry then travels with MTW missionaries, Richard and Robyn Crane, to Cuba Thursday 18th - Monday 22nd. They will meet with local church leaders to discuss and plan for MTW's on-going ministry in Cuba. Please pray for the meetings and for guidance as we plan for the future.

Jeffery and Ruthann Knight will be teaching a class at The Grenada Institute for Theological Education this week (Monday 1st - Friday 5th). The class will give practical skills and practices in ministering to teenage youth. Pray for the class to be effective in better preparing the students to be effective in youth ministry in their local churches. There is a critical need to reach the youth throughout the Caribbean. Ask God to start a spiritual awakening in the Caribbean, especially among young men.
