Sermon Text: Mark 6 :30-44

Sermon Title: Without a Shepherd?

TE Ken Godwin

Main Idea: Out of compassion for the crowds because they "were like sheep without a shepherd," Jesus taught them "many things," providing spiritual sustenance. The physical sustenance He subsequently provided was a sign that His authority to teach was given by God the Father in the power of the Spirit.
