Sermon Text: 2 Kings 2:19-25

Sermon Title: Jesus Meets us in the Ruins of Jericho

Chaplin Andrew Spriensma

Proposition: The Lord Jesus Christ, as the eternal Word of God, has power over the curse, both to pronounce, but also to reverse.

Question: Where are the accursed things in your life that Jesus comes to heal?

I. Jericho: The curse reversed. (vv.19-22)

II. Bethel: The curse pronounced. (vv.23-25)
